PROGRAM OUTLINE

- Kinder Dance is a therapy group aimed at supporting preschool-aged children to develop the skills required to engage in community-based dance classes.
- The group will focus on developing your child's confidence, gross motor and social skills through song and dance.
- Parents may volunteer to support the session, but are not required to do so. Parents are encouraged to attend the end of term performances.
- The group will be facilitated by an Occupational Therapist, in consultation with a multi-disciplinary team.

COST

\$58.53/session
