School- Aged Social Skills Group



PROGRAM OUTLINE

- School Mates group is designed to teach primary school aged children enrolled in a specialist school setting about social skills. Children will learn about making friends and the skills needed to be a good friend.
- Targeted and scaffolded teaching of social thinking skills based on the *Thinking About You, Thinking About Me* framework. This incorporates social awareness, emotional awareness, teamwork and negotiating with others
- Facilitated by an Occupational Therapist in consultation with a multidisciplinary team

COST

\$58.53/session

- Helping Children with Autism and Better Start programs may also be used
