Lego Club is aimed to support children in Lower Primary school to develop their social skills and fine motor skills through the medium of Lego and other construction materials. The program is on the concepts within the Lego Therapy framework, whereby small groups of children work together on a group project communicating, problem solving and negotiating to achieve a shared goal. The group will be facilitated by an Occupational Therapist in consultation with a multidisciplinary team.
