PROGRAM OUTLINE

Social Caterpillars is a social skills group program for younger primary school girls. It is designed to help girls to develop their thought processes in challenging social situations. Social Caterpillars teaches social skills, focusing on problem solving, flexible thinking and the principles and practice of social thinking strategies utilising the *SuperFlex* framework and concepts. The group is facilitated by a Speech Pathologist or Occupational Therapist in consultation with a multidisciplinary team.
